

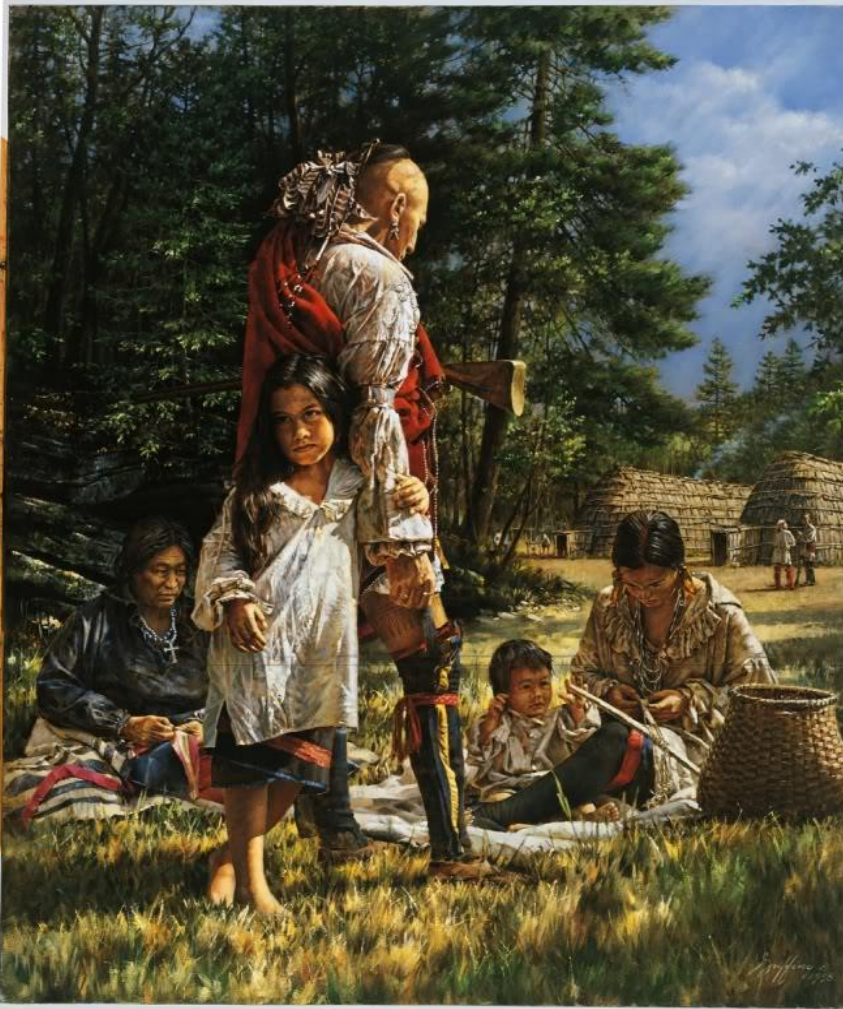
HISTORY OPEN HOUSE
