- Trick or Treat during daylight hours. Being able to see and be seen makes it easier to maintain social distance. Sunset is 6pm on Halloween this year. Trick or Treat curfew is 8pm.
- Avoid large groups.
- Be respectful of your neighbors who need to opt out this year.
