What Is WIC?

WIC is a free nutrition education and supplemental food program.

Who May Be Eligible?

- Women-Pregnant, postpartum (up to six months), or breastfeeding women (up to one year)
 - Infants: From birth through first birthday
 - Children: Up to age five

What Does WIC Provide?

Many people do no get enough of important nutrients in their diet. These nutrients are especially important during pregnancy, nursing, infancy, and early childhood.

WIC provides nutrition assessment and counseling for you and your children. Free WIC food vouchers to use at local food markets. Breastfeeding support. Referrals for health care, and Immunization screening.

In Order To Qualify for WIC, You Must Meet The Following Criteria:

- Must Meet Income Guidelines
 - Must Live In New Jersey
- Must Have a Nutritional Need to Receive a Supplemental Food Package
 - Must Meet All Of The Above Criteria
