## WHAT'S HAPPENING IN JANUARY 2026

**LEAF COLLECTION HAS ENDED** – the next leaf collection will take place Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> through Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup>. Outside of the scheduled Leaf Collection times, leaves may be bagged and put out with weekly trash.

ANNUAL DOG & CAT LICENSING BEGINS January 2<sup>nd</sup>. All Dogs & Cats residing in the Township, must be licensed in January. State Law requires that your pet's Rabies Vaccination must be valid through October 2026. Click here for the Dog and Cat License Form. Completed forms, payment, proof of Rabies Certificate (must be valid through October 31<sup>st</sup> of the Licensing Year), and Spay/Neuter Certificate, along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope may be submitted via mail or placed in the secure payment drop box at Delanco Township Municipal Building, 770 Coopertown Road, Delanco, NJ 08075. ### **THINGS TO REMEMBER:**

❖ IN THE EVENT OF SNOW: Please do not park your car in the street for 48 hours after a snow fall so the Delanco Public Works can clear the streets from curb to curb eliminating the buildup of ice along the curbs. State Law requires that no snow is to be thrown into the street after the streets have been plowed.

The Township would like to remind all property owners that they are responsible for removing all snow and ice from the sidewalks in front of their property within 12 hours of a snowfall. This is required by ordinance and enforcement and penalties have been set in the ordinance. Most children in Delanco walk to school and dangerous sidewalks are a liability to you as the property owner. Please comply with this ordinance.

❖ State Law and Local Ordinance require that **ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED** in January.

2026 Licenses are available at the Township Clerk's Office in the Municipal Building, beginning **Friday, January 2nd, 2026**. Reminders will be mailed out at the end of December.

#### **❖ BASKETBALL COURTS MAY NOT BE STORED IN THE STREET**

Per Chapter 297 of the Delanco Township Code, it shall be unlawful for an individual to store recreational equipment in, on or above right-of-way within the Township. This prohibition is intended to extend to basketball backboards, where the base of the backboard is placed outside of the right-of-way, but a portion of the structure extends into area above the right-of-way. This can create a dangerous condition in the event of snow in particular, as plows come through to remove the snow.
