#### > TRASH DISPOSAL OF MATTRESSES

We have been informed by our solid waste collection provider, Seaside Waste, that effective immediately, all mattresses must be fully wrapped in plastic/tarp material and secured with tape or secured inside a mattress disposal bag. Unwrapped mattresses or those that are not fully secure will not be collected.

- RECYCLING CART PLACEMENT, where you place your cart for collection is just as important as what goes in! <u>Click here</u> for details.
- SWIMMING POOLS—Permits are required for Swimming Pools which can hold water 24 inches or more in depth. (Township Code, Chapter 254) This includes inground, aboveground and on-ground swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, regardless if they are permanent structures or will be take down at the end of the summer.
- GRASS CLIPPINGS and/or other debris may not be blown into the street as it is a violation of our storm water plan and ordinance 2006-04. This type of debris can be washed by rain into the storm drains, then directly to our water supplies. Grass may be bagged and put out with your regular trash. Let's work together to keep Delanco a Clean Community!
- HELP KEEP MOSQUITO POPULATIONS DOWN BY EMPTYING, DRAINING, REMOVING OR COVERING ANY CONTAINER THAT CAN HOLD WATER. Change water in birdbaths frequently, a least once a week. Remember NO STANDING WATER = NO MOSQUITOS. <u>Click</u> <u>here</u> for more tips to help with Mosquito control.
