THE BURLINGTON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT WILL BE OFFERING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS TO ALL BURLINGTON COUNTY RESIDENTS 6 MONTHS AND OLDER. PRIMARY SERIES DOSES, AS WELL AS BOOSTER DOSES, WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL AGE GROUPS, WITH BOTH MODERNA AND PFIZER FORMULATIONS AVAILABLE.

PLEASE NOTE: AS OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2023 THE PFIZER AND MODERNA 2023-24 MONOVALENT VACCINES ARE THE ONLY MRNA VACCINES AUTHORIZED AND AVAILABLE FOR PRIMARY SERIES DOSES, AS WELL AS BOOSTER DOSES. RESIDENTS 65 YEARS AND OLDER ARE NOW ELIGIBLE FOR AN ADDITIONAL BOOSTER OF 23/24 MONOVALENT VACCINE, AS LONG AS IT HAS BEEN 4 OR MORE MONTHS SINCE THEIR PREVIOUS DOSE.
