

**Presentations on the Proposed New DMV Building scheduled for Tues. Aug 2
at the Delanco Municipal Building**

Please be advised that on Tuesday evening August 2 at the Delanco Municipal Building at 770 Coopertown Rd., there will be two sessions dealing with plans by the State of New Jersey to convert the existing closed Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Inspection Station on their property at 400 Creek Road in Delanco to a new one-storey DMV Commission Office Building with associated parking and vehicle testing areas.

Between 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. representatives of the NJ Division of Property Management & Construction (DPMC) and their consultants will host a required Public Forum on their Proposed No Net Loss Reforestation Plan for the new facility. The proposed site improvements are anticipated to impact 4.01 acres of forested area within the property. Their reforestation application along with supporting documentation and mapping will be made available to the public. Interested parties are invited to attend to see the plan, hear a brief presentation, be able to ask question of the representatives and register opinions and comments on the plan. Please view the public notice, which follows, for more details.

Starting at 7:00 pm the Delanco Joint Land Use Board (JLUB) is scheduled to hear a more formal presentation of the full site plan proposal for the new DMV facility. However, because this is a State facility, the applicant is not obligated to make this presentation nor must they get formal approval from the JLUB to proceed with their plans. The State DPMC representatives agreed to make this presentation and listen to and react to any comments or questions.

Copies of the plans for the DMV site are available for public inspection in the Borough Clerk's office during regular business hours (M-F, 9 am – 4 pm).
