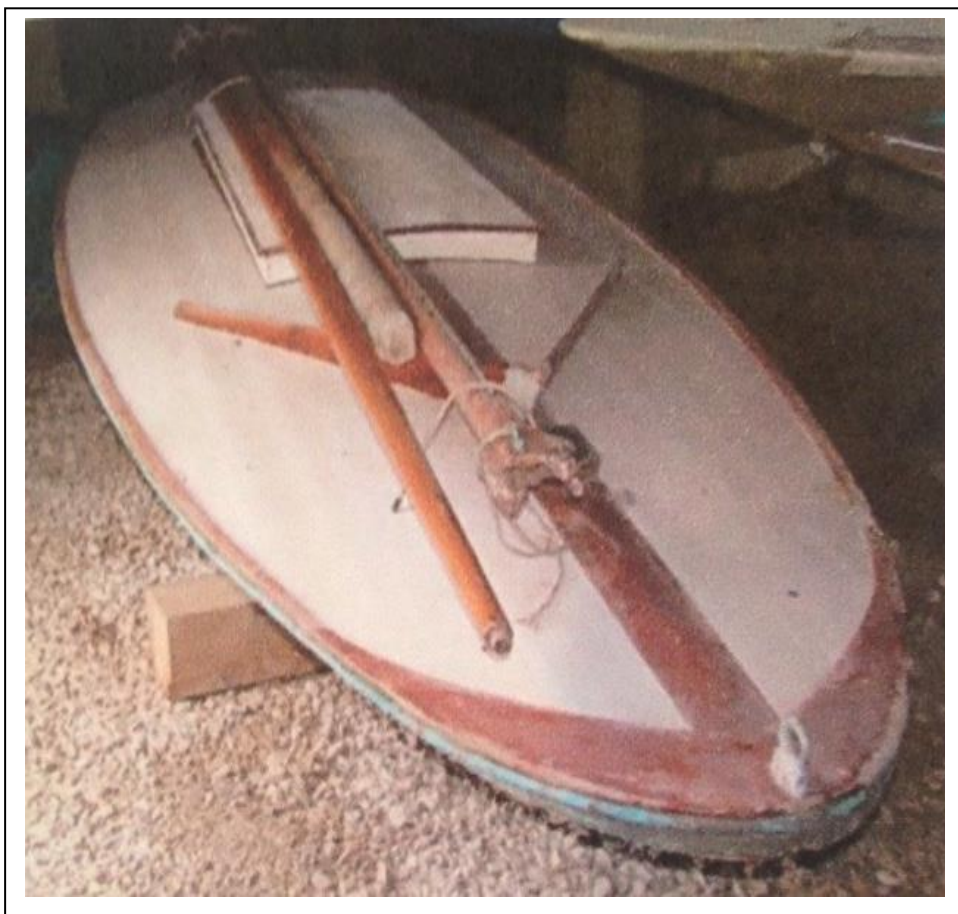


HISTORY OPEN HOUSE

AT DELANCO TOWNSHIP

From Tuesday, July 16 to Saturday, July 20, 2024,
Delanco History Board will be on the road
with a public display in the History Faire Tent
at Burlington County Farm Fair at the Fairgrounds.

We will return to Delanco for our regular
Third Saturday History Open House on Saturday, August 17.



Delanco's featured display at the History Faire will be the "*Monty C. Sprite*", an early 1900's sailing sneakbox built in Delanco at the Louis D. Steel Boatyard.

These boats were once in common use by Delanco watermen for duck hunting and fishing on the Delaware and Rancocas.

They were also raced competitively at local canoe clubs like the *Monte Carlo Canoe Club* in Delanco and the *Red Dragon Canoe Club* in Edgewater Park.

The boat is on loan from Tuckerton Seaport Museum in Tuckerton, New Jersey.
