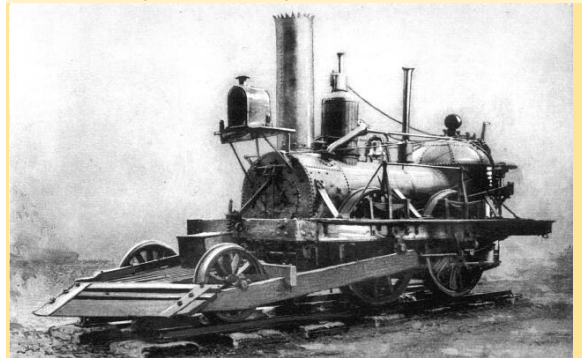

The John Bull locomotive was built in England by Robert and George Stephenson. It was disassembled and shipped to Bordentown, where it was assembled by Isaac Dripps and went into service on the Camden & Amboy Railway in 1834.
