Dear Members of Congress, Legislators, County and Municipal Officials, and Stakeholders:

On October 15, 2022, NJ TRANSIT will begin needed track repairs to the River LINE Light Rail Transit System between the Cinnaminson and Riverside Stations. NJ TRANSIT remains committed to providing reliable service to all our River LINE customers during this project. We have worked to ensure minimal inconvenience to customers with no service suspension during the project.

We are performing the track work in two phases to minimize the disruption to the normal River LINE schedule to better accommodate riders. The repair work will occur in two, two-week phases, with a restoration to the normal River LINE service schedule for one week between the two work phases.

River LINE light rail trains will be replaced by buses between the Riverside and Cinnaminson Stations during the two work periods. Buses will board and discharge in front of each station where customers can then board waiting trains and continue to their destinations. Bus and light rail schedules are being coordinated to maintain minimal time between connections. See **Sunday through Friday** River LINE schedule HERE. See **Saturday** River LINE schedule HERE.

- During the track work, the River LINE schedule will be adjusted to one-half hour service. Customers should allow for extra travel time and plan their travel accordingly.
- The first two-week phase of track work will begin on Saturday, October 15, 2022, through Friday, October 28, 2022. Bus service will be substituted between the two stations.
- On Saturday, October 29, 2022, the River LINE will return to the normal schedule for one week with no train service interruption and no busing required between the Cinnaminson and Riverside Stations. Regular service will continue through Friday, November 4, 2022.
- The second two-week phase of track work will begin on Saturday, November 5, 2022, through Friday, November 18, 2022. Bus service will be substituted between the two stations.

• On Saturday, November 19, 2022, the River LINE will return to its normal schedule with no train service interruption.

We are working to provide customers with advance notification of the schedule adjustment. Posters will be prominently displayed at all stations and onboard all light rail vehicles. Customers are encouraged to monitor Travel Alerts & Advisories, sign up for My Transit Alerts, download the NJ TRANSIT app and follow us on Social Media for the latest service information.
