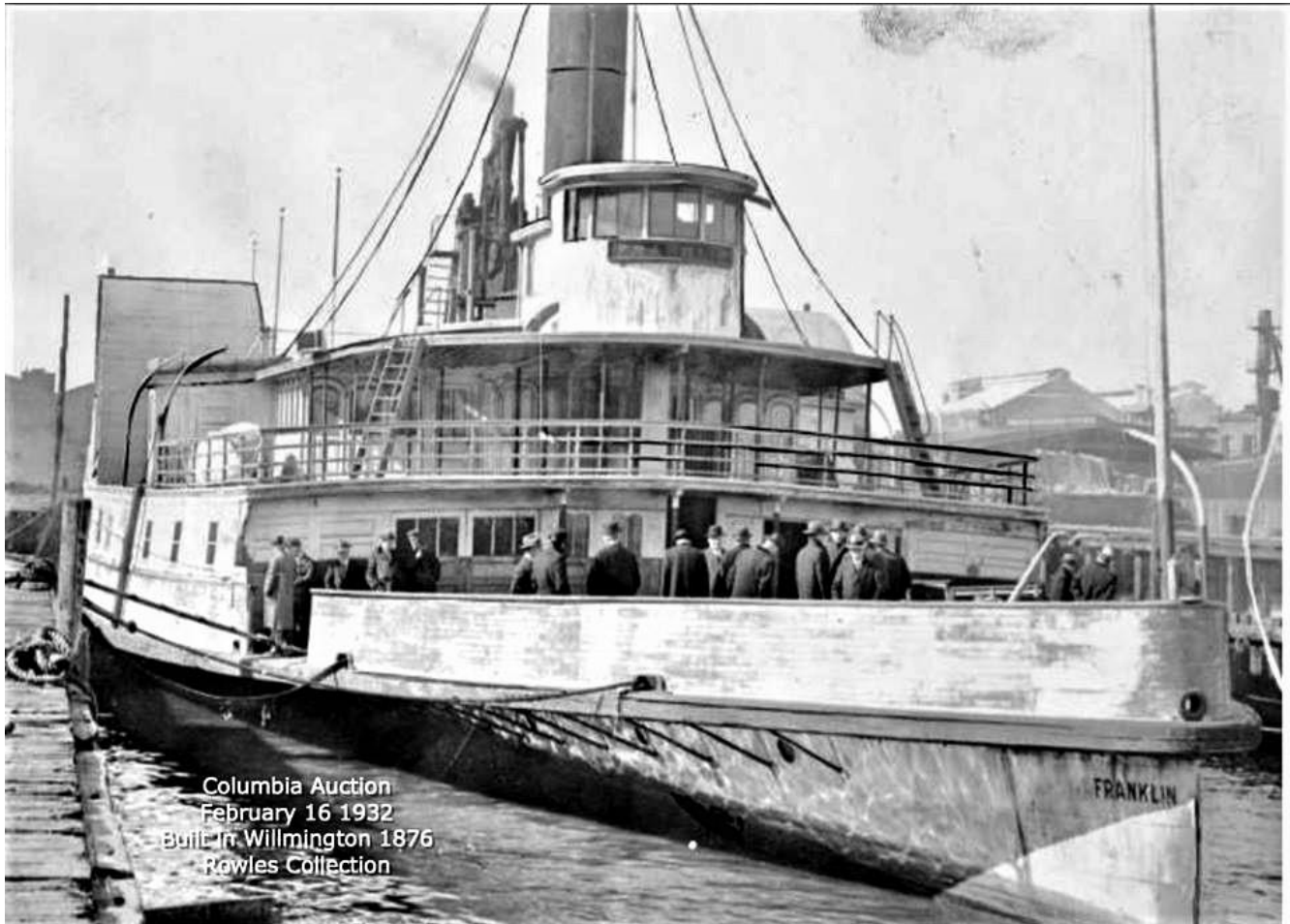


# HISTORY OPEN HOUSE
